Sanction has therefore been accorded by the Vice-Chancellor to implement the above resolution of the Syndicate.



Norms and Guidelines regarding Research Grant to Research Centres of Affiliated Colleges for publishing academic journals

Criteria for Selection of Research Centres

- 1.Application for Research Grant for publication of Academic Journals to be invited from affiliated colleges of the University with approved Research Centres established prior to 2017.
- 2.The number of researchers in the college in the approved centres should be atleast 20 with a minimum of five research guides collectively in all disciplines as on the date of application.
- 3.For existing journals, the journal being published from the Centre should be of approved status- Peer reviewed journals which are Scopus indexed/CARE listed and with ISSN Number.
- 4.For centres coming up with new journals, the journal should be with ISSN number and peer reviewed.A well established Editorial Board , Reviewers' panel and Advisory Board is mandated .The editor should be from within the college and an approved Research guide of the institution with good academic credentials.
- 5.The Reviewers' Panel and Advisory Board should consist of renowned academicians with representation of foreign academicians as well.
- 6.Standard guidelines on inviting Scholarly papers, peer reviewing papers, submission of review reports to authors and publication of content should be complied with.
- 7.The support of University should be acknowledged in all issues of journal.
- 8.Check for Plagiarism should be ensured.
- 9.The amount given as grant must be exclusively used in enhancing the quality of journal.
